## Woman assault man in wheelchair

Sheriff's deputies arrested **33-year-old Crestline resident Veronica Dantonoli** for elder abuse after she assaulted a man in a wheelchair with a flashlight.

Sheriff's officials said on July 28, just before 9:00 p.m., the 78-year-old victim, whose name is being withheld, saw Dantonoli in his rear yard and confronted her, demanding to know what she was doing in his yard. According to the deputy's report, the victim demanded that Dantonoli leave his property and followed her to the front yard in his wheelchair to make sure she left.

Dantonoli is reported to have started yelling at the victim, stating, "You loser old man in a wheelchair," and threw the flashlight she had been carrying with her at him. Deputies said the flashlight struck the victim in the head, causing redness, swelling and pain to the victim's head.

Dantonoli is reported to have left the property, after which the victim notified the Sheriff's Department. While conducting an area search, deputies located Dantonoli in the area of Lake Drive and WildRose Lane. Dantonoli was arrested for violation of California Penal Code (PC) Section 368(c) (causes injury to elder adult); Bail was set at \$50,000.

When Dantonoli appeared before Superior Court Judge Douglas N. Gericke on August 1, she was formally charged with violation of PC 368(c) (causing injury to elder adult) and violation of PC 245(a)(4), (assault with a deadly weapon likely to produce great bodily injury.) Bail was confirmed at \$50,000 and a pre-trial date of August 11 in Department S7 was scheduled.

If convicted of PC 368(c), the maximum penalty is imprisonment in the county jail not to exceed one year, a fine, not to exceed \$2,000, or by a combination of fine and imprisonment. If convicted of PC 254(a) (4), the maximum penalty is imprisonment in the state prison not to exceed four years, a fine not to exceed \$10,000, or by both a fine and imprisonment.
